

THE DIANA AWARD ANTI-BULLYING AMBASSADOR_TRAINING

The Diana Award Anti-Bullying Campaign would like to invite you to our Anti-Bullying Ambassador Training Day!

What is an Anti-Bullying Ambassador training day?

An 'Anti Bullying Ambassador training day' is an event held at a school or venue where up to 150 students from one area will come together to be trained as Anti-Bullying Ambassadors. Students will network with other passionate young people, exchange ideas and share good practice. Attending a training day will help kick start or develop your schools Anti-Bullying work and allow students to creatively explore and understand the topic of bullying.

Who is the training for?

Anti-Bullying Ambassador training supported by Facebook is targeted towards young people aged 12-18 within an educational setting. **This training is for secondary schools only** but for all abilities. Staff members will also receive separate training on the day.

What is the price to attend?

The training is supported by Facebook with a particular focus on reaching new schools. The price for schools who have already undertaken our Anti-Bullying Ambassador training will be £22 +VAT per pupil and £15 +VAT per staff. Schools that are new to the programme will be charged £11 +VAT per pupil and £15 +VAT per staff member. We are keen to ensure schools have access to this programme, so please do get in touch if there are circumstances which mean you are unable to allow for this cost.

What is included with the price?

Each student will receive a training booklet, a guide to take home to their parent/guardians, branded pen and pencil, Anti-Bullying Ambassador badge, notepad, wristband and a certificate for attending the day. Each staff member will receive a 1 hour training session and a guide for staff members with ideas on



good practice to take back to your school. Ongoing support will be provided to your Anti-Bullying Ambassadors once trained.

What will students learn from the day?

Students will leave the day feeling inspired and full of fantastic ideas! The event will cover:

- Understanding the issue of bullying; facts, the definition and the effects of bullying
- Practical ideas, top tips and explore scenarios on bullying in groups
- Basic training looking at the skills needed to support others and stay safe
- Online safety and approaches students and staff can take to staying safe online and educating their peers
- A networking session with students from other schools to share ideas
- Video examples of schools we currently work with
- Action planning – helping students to think of a plan to take back to school and set targets and aims for their Anti-Bullying work
- Plus lots more including fun games...!

What is the impact of the programme and likely results for my school?

Schools have seen increased attendance, attainment, improved behaviour and reduction of bullying with anti-bullying work contributing to positive Ofsted inspection reports. What time does the event start and finish?

We ask that you arrive between 9am and 9.15am for a prompt 9.45am start. The training will finish at 3.30pm. It is crucial to the training that all staff and students remain for the whole day in order not to miss action planning and certificate presentations.



Do staff need to attend?

Yes, staff need to attend as they play a crucial part in supporting Anti-Bullying Ambassadors and their success. Staff will work through their own staff workbook throughout the day and plan ideas with the team.

What if I need to cancel?

A cancellation fee is in place to cover the cost of resources and materials produced. Please refer to the cancellation policy attachment sent with your booking confirmation.

Is school uniform required?

We suggest full school uniform as this will help your students think about their identity as Anti-Bullying Ambassadors.

How many staff/students should attend from each school?

We recommend sending a team of between 6-15 young people per school to allow for a manageable team to implement the programme successfully. We recommend 2-3 members of staff depending on your group size. It is advisable to send a mixture of year groups to ensure you have Anti-Bullying Ambassadors throughout the school.

Will lunch or refreshments be provided?

Both staff and students will need to bring their own packed lunch – refreshments will be provided.

Will there be any photographs/videos taken at the event?

Yes, we ask that you complete the photo consent form we send you once you have booked your places and bring this along on the day to confirm whether or not we have permission to take your students photographs.
